- All pertinent information about the student (name, address, telephone number)

- A signed copy of the scholarship proposal acknowledging and agreeing to all issues contained here within.

All awards will be directed to the student. The date, time, and place of the presentation of awards has not yet been decided. Any student that applies for consideration for a Brigantine Elks Scholarship award acknowledges and accepts that the decision of the Scholarship Committee is final and cannot be contested for any reason.

These scholarships are distributed in a manner that precludes any favoritism. All applications are processed by the Committee Chair and submitted to the Committee Members without showing personal information, such as name and address. The recipients are selected by a majority vote of the Committee Members as soon as possible after the cutoff date of June 15th.
